The menu at Hub Stacey's is exceptional. The appetizers include comfort foods with a twist like corn fritters, fried portabella mushrooms, onion rings, potato skins, quesadillas... and the list goes on!

Now where Hub Stacey's REALLY gets your attention is with the burgers. These things are HUGE, and come dressed in so many creative ways. The Hubba Bubba is a half pound of happiness... covered in Swiss cheese, sauteed mushrooms, and gravy. In all seriousness, this is one of the best burgers I have ever had. I tried SO hard to eat every bite, and I almost would have made it... if I hadn't had to finish the french fries, too! Another favorite seems to be the Loaded F.F. Burger covered in (you guessed it) french fries, nacho cheese, bacon bits, and a side of sour cream.

And Hub Stacey's also dishes out beautifully crafted sandwiches, such as the Point... pastrami piled so high on rye bread that you wonder how you can possibly eat it all! (But you sure try!) There is also a Hubba Bubba sandwich, which has all the same toppings as the burger, but this time on lean, roast beef.
