
Ernest Hemingway Home & Museum

Ernest Hemingway, one of America's most loved and respected writers, lived in this beautiful home from 1931 to 1961. He wrote many novels while

living here, including *To Have And To Have Not*, which was actually set right here in Key West during the Great Depression.□
