However, one of the crowning moments concludes just before the break for intermission, when Lady Macbeth, played by Jessica Frances Dukes, stalks away from the ruined dinner, dragging with her the tablecloth, as she exits the stage to a maniacal version of "Everybody Wants To Rule The World".
